


Moody's today are built by Germany's Hanse Yachts AG, but back in 1826, it was John Moody of Swanwick on England's Hamble river who started the company that over the latter decades of the 20th C became synonymous with sturdy, voluminous cruiser-racer yachts, with an emphasis on cruising.

A centre cockpit is a feature of many Moody's, but the 38S has a more racy aft cockpit. The photo opposite is of SOLer ybw_mjm's Jubilant off the Isle of Wight probably before the start of the 2013 Fastnet Race with a rare mix of SOLers on board. It was an epic adventure. Online SOLers got a feel for the challenge by pacing Jubilant in her qualifiers for the event but stayed ashore and wished her well when the Squadron's cannon fired the starting shot.
