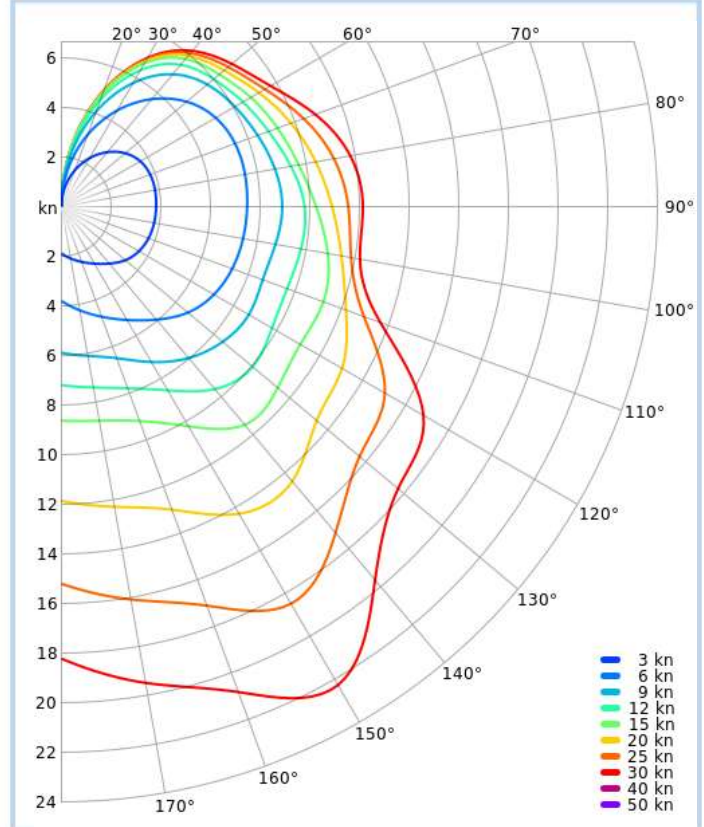

First there was the Mumm 36 designed by Bruce Farr, later came the Farr 40, and then in 2003 Harry Dunning, erstwhile employee of Bruce Farr, in collaboration with world-renowned builder McConaghy Boats, prompted by a group of Australian owners, keen to buy into a super strict high performance offshore keelboat class, launched the MC38.

A year later, the design won SailWorld magazine's 'Boat of the Year' award. But things do not always work out as planned, and, although the MC38 is an impressive machine and by all accounts value for money, she has not gone on to become the new international offshore one-design class the promoters had in mind. At SOL though, we like the look of her a lot, perhaps because her polar has a few interesting bumps.
