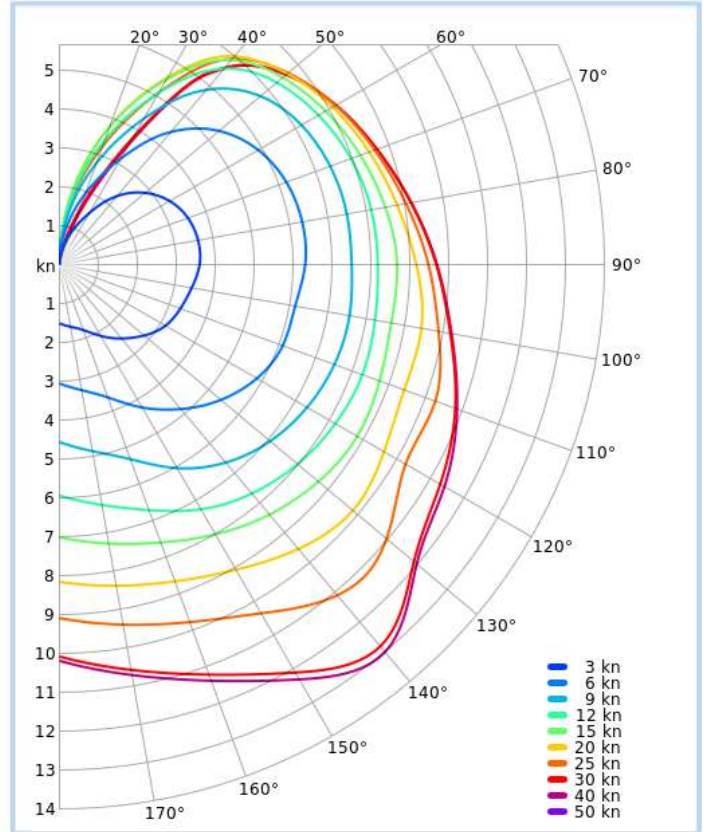


First 40.7 v2

Of all their something .7's, the First 40.7 has been the hardest to beat – on the race course, and in your pocket. Designed by Bruce Farr (again) and launched in 1999, over 700 had been built by the time the yacht went out of production in 2008, both shallower draft versions for cruising and deep draft racing machines. It goes beyond this researcher's patience to inventorise the many successes achieved by First 40.7s, and Kenwood Cup and Commodore Cup places these boats have won. Lots.

We got our hands on an accurate polar diagram for the deep draft racer in 2010, named her v2 and took her for a sail around Turkey. Since then we have raced her irregularly, but never again more than 1400nm waypoint-to-waypoint!
